BACKGROUND

The service is provided in UK and Republic of Ireland with Company employees based at several offices and Depots.

The business, which has a Head Office in Scotland, has been in existence for over 45 years serving an established customer base. Policies and procedures have been developed to support the activities of the business.

DUE DILIGENCE

The risk of slavery and human trafficking within the organisation is effectively avoided as a result of the implementation of strict policies and procedures.

The Company is registered with the Supplier Ethical Data Exchange, (SEDEX), and is subject to independent ethical auditing. Auditing by significant customers is also a feature of the risk control measures.

The highest identified risk of slavery and human trafficking is considered within the supply chain which is predominantly UK and ROI subcontract haulage providers and vendors and service providers. Significant contractors are subject to a program of audit as part of the approval process.
