Through the risk assessment of identified hazards the Company policy is to remove risks where practical and then introduce workplace precautions and controls which minimize and control any residual risk.


All employees will be issued with information relevant to their position in our organisation during their induction and follow up training to ensure they can perform to the highest levels of competence and safety.
